

Arabian Air Pass

EK Arabian Air Pass extends customer international business, cultural discovery or luxury travel to Middle East destinations, when booking an International (applicable for international flights EK tickets with itineraries originating outside Middle East) EK flight to the region.

- Arabian Air pass offers multiple daily EK and EK operated by FZ flights choices for connections to 14 regional points. Arabian Air Pass must be issued as a separate ticket in connection with an EK International Return Ticket with Fare value higher than 500USD, where the international journey originates outside of the following countries: Bahrain, Egypt, Iran, Iraq, Israel, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Oman, Saudi Arabia and UAE.
- It must be booked on EK marketed flights operated by EK or FZ; not valid on FZ prime flight numbers.
- Can be purchased after commencement of international journey, but not after commencement of travel from the turnaround point of the itinerary.

Eligibility

- Air Pass is valid for travel on EK flights operated by EK or FZ only.
- Air Pass must be issued as a separate ticket and must be issued in connection with an EK International Return Ticket where the international journey originates outside of the following countries: Bahrain, Egypt, Iran, Iraq, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Oman, Saudi Arabia, and UAE.
- To be eligible for AAP, the value of the international ticket must not be less than USD 500/- (inclusive of fuel), (excluding Skywards redemption tickets, ID, AD, DG, or promotional tickets).
- Air Pass can be purchased after the commencement of the international journey but not after the commencement of travel from the turnaround point of the itinerary.
- Number of coupons: Minimum 2 coupons, maximum 8 coupons.
- Sales Validity: Valid for sales on/before **31st March 2024**.
- All Air Pass fares are manual and taxes will have to be calculated as per the GDS
- Blackouts: As per international ticket

Reservation:

- Confirmed reservations required for all air pass sectors. Enter: 4OSI EK AIRPASS
- Number of coupons: Minimum 2 coupons, maximum 8 coupons
- Booking class (RBD) to be used as per the international ticket booking class (RBD).
If more than one booking class is used for the international ticket, book in the lowest booking class on the international journey e.g. if LON-DXB-BKK-DXB-LON is booked in Q, Air pass sectors must be booked in "Q";
If the LON-DXB-BKK sectors in B-class and BKK-DXB-LON in W class, then Air pass sectors must be booked in "B".
Any EK Premium Economy class market fare to Australia/New Zealand except RBD 'W'
Purchase of AAP is permitted in First and Business Class, using booking class A and O respectively, permitted with Economy class.
If the international ticket is First or Business Class purchase of Economy AAP is permitted with booking class Y.

If the international ticket is First purchase of Business AAP is permitted with booking class 'C'
AAP booking classes will be V, O, and A for Economy, Business, and First Class respectively If the international ticket is a Skywards Redemption ticket.

Ticketing Details:

AAP ticket must be endorsed with the international ticket number i.e.
"Issued in connection with 176...../SKYWARDS*" in the endorsement box
Fare box should reflect Equivalent fare as per fare matrix in local currency using BSR on the date of issue

Fares Display / Quote:

All Air Pass fares are manual and taxes will have to be calculated as per the GDS

Fare Basis:

RBD + No. of coupons + AP + brand indicator+ME+9. Annotate /CH for child and /IN for infant passenger respectively.
e.g. If the international ticket is in K class and the passenger is buying 4 coupons, the fare basis should be: K4APSM9
Fare Brand indicator by RBD:
Flex + "F" (F/J/C/W/E/Y/R/X)
Flex "S" (A/I/M/B/U/K)
Saver "P" (O/Q/L/T)
Special "R" (H/V)

Combinations:

Open Jaw is permitted provided air pass journey commences in DXB e.g. DXBAMM // CAIDXB
Mixed class permitted e.g. DXBDAM in First class and DAMDXB in Economy class permitted.
Permitted with global fare products i.e. Air/Sea, Missionary, Seaman, Student, Corporates, Emirates Holidays, etc. However, no discounts apply to the AAP sectors.
Not permitted with Group fares.

Notes:

- If an upgrade is required on AAP sectors from Economy to Business / First class or from Business to First Class, a charge of USD 50 applies in addition to the difference in fare.
- In case of No-Show, only one fee is to be charged i.e. either the no-show fee or the re-issue / reroute fee whichever is higher
- Party utilised AAP - Deduct the fare & taxes of each used sector and apply refund fee. The rest can be refunded provided minimum 2 AAP sectors coupons are used
- Refund of International Ticket - In accordance with the refund policies, the International ticket can be refunded only with the fully unutilised Air pass
- In case of No-Show, only one fee is to be charged i.e. either the no-show fee or the re-issue / reroute fee whichever is higher
